

wedding, Knockderry is one of the most romantic and picturesque country house wedding venues in Scotland.

The hotel is situated by the shores of Loch Long, with beautiful views across the water, set in grounds with mature trees and wide lawns. Ideal for outdoor wedding photography.

Knockderry was built in the mid 19th Century and redesigned in the 1890s by celebrated architect William Leiper. It has been lovingly restored for the last 15 years to bring out its original features: beautiful external architecture of half-timbered walls, quirky dormers and turrets, and internal details such as intricate Indian carvings, stunning panelling and delicate mouldings.



A range of artwork is displayed throughout the hotel, and each room is individually and beautifully designed. The drawing room, with its wood carvings, stained glass windows and fireplace, is comfortable and welcoming and a wonderful spot for a drink and a chat.

The Library suite is composed of a comfortable lounge and dressing area and separate king-sized bedroom and bathroom. With views over the loch, it is the perfect spot to get ready in a relaxed and luxurious setting.



Ceremonies are held either on the terrace or in the wood-panelled dining room which boasts its stunning views over the loch. The wedding breakfast is served in the gallery. On warm days, the doors to the grounds can be open for reception drinks and photos on the terrace, with guests milling around freely.

The whole event, including menus and timetable, is designed in full consultation with you, according to your style and preferences.



On the first night, your guests will be welcome to the hotel for a few drinks and a beautiful welcome buffet from our 2 AA Rosette chefs. This is the perfect opportunity to ensure everyone arrives comfortably and has a chance to catch up and mingle before the wedding.

On your wedding day, after a good breakfast, everyone can spend time exploring the grounds and the local area, take a stroll by the shores of Loch Long, or simply relax in the hotel before getting ready for the ceremony.





The beautiful library suite is yours for both nights so the bride has plenty to room to get ready with her party before the ceremony. The couple and their wedding party can calm their nerves in the drawing room with a wee dram.

The ceremony will be held in the dining room, transformed for the occasion, or on the terrace, with the wedding breakfast served later in the gallery. Chairs, linen and wedding stationery are all included and the table layout will be chosen with you. Your wedding cake will be ready and waiting on a stand which can be provided unless you wish to bring your own.
